

Feature to Scott

North Battleford's Marion Scott captured top honors at the annual North Battleford women's bonspiel which finished Tuesday a North Battleford Curling Club.

Scott defeated clubmate Gene Guest 8-5 in the 'A event final to capture the Boyd Brothers' trophy in the 60-rink 'spiel.

However, Guest didn't leave the competition empty handed. The North Battleford skipper won the Molson's Special event and was the grand aggregate champion, finishing the 'spiel with an 8-1 win-loss record.

North Battleford rinks placed on top in three other

events. Beryl Lamon was the B-event winner, receiving the Asmussen trophy, Rose Alcock won the Hollis trophy for taking the E event and Helen Woodcock was the F event champ, receiving the Holtet trophy. Woodcock defeated Saskatoon's Marion Taylor in that final.

Battleford's Elsie Boulton was the C-event winner, earning the Sterling trophy, and was also named the visitors aggregate champ.

Gene Ostertag of Lloydminster won the Dean trophy placing on top in the D event while Floss Nelson of Unity took home the Elliot trophy, winning the G event.
