

North Battleford Makes Plans For Annual Bonspiel

The new five-sheet curling rink has just been completed, and the rink with its two steam-heated waiting-rooms, each measuring sixteen by seventy feet, will make a splendid home for the curlers.

It is believed that a membership of one hundred and twenty curlers will be enrolled at this point this season, and an endeavor will be made to send representative rinks to each bonspiel held within reasonable distance.
