NORTH BATTLEFORD
Gord Helloffs of North Battleford, aided by third Jack Berg, second Rich Ternier and lead Alvin Welychko, took top honors recently in the annual North Battleford Granite Curling Club's harvest bonspiel.

Helloffs defeated Al Ulmer of N.B. in the main event final. Bob Beranek and Herb Macdonald, both of North Battleford, placed third and fourth.

Jack Murphy of Radisson emerged the victor in the second event, with Jim Porter, North Battleford, second; Mike Lukowich, Speers, third and Harry Griffiths, N.B., fourth.

The third event went to Jack Jones of Denholm, Bruce Wilson, Guy Parent and Lou Gillen, all of North Battleford, followed Jones in that order.

Art Webb of North Battleford downed Jim Ballendine of Battleford in the final of the fourth event.

Dr. George Beall, who has operated the Saskatoon bonspiel on an "automatic draw" basis for the last three years, has been hired by the Regina bonspiel committee to hold a similar chore there.

The Regina bonspiel will run from Feb. 13 to 18, just the week previous to the Saskatoon 'spiel, where Dr. Beall will also prevail.

In Regina, there will be 16 events and Dr. Beall will work on a draw that will include 288 rinks.

"B" section final. Miss Rayner earlier downed Mrs. Bea Cavill while Mrs. Beerling sidelined Mrs. Eleanor Van Impe.

In the "A" section, Miss Rayner won out over Mrs. Vern Braithwaite while Mrs. Van Impe stopped Mrs. Sasseville.
